Keep Your Biotech Staff Current on the Latest Trends, Methods and Regulations,

(Or Your Organization Could Pay a Steep Price).

Few fields have experienced the advancements, changing regulations and scientific breakthroughs we've seen in biotechnology. And if your biotech workforce isn't up to date on and using the latest developments, your entire organization will suffer.

Because keeping skills and knowledge on the cutting edge is so vital, Harrisburg University of Science and Technology and the Baruch S. Blumberg Institute have teamed up to offer the Biotechnology Certificate Program. The program covers three critical areas:

- Certificate in Biomanufacturing in Biotechnology – Gain essential skills of industrial bioprocessing and prepare for a supervisory or managerial role in a biomanufacturing company or contract manufacturing organization.
- Certificate in Regulatory Affairs in Biotechnology – Acquire the skills to assume leadership positions within the regulatory affairs unit of a biotechnology organization. Learn about tech transfer policies and IPOs, how to communicate scientific concepts to investors and prepare regulatory plans.
- Certificate in Medical Biotechnology – Understand the basics of diagnostics, biomarker studies and drug discovery, then be able to use the available information to develop new, targeted therapies for precision medicine. Learn about emerging MedTech trends in Biomedical Devices and Regenerative Medicine

Designed for working professionals, each certificate takes two semesters to complete and includes four courses worth a total of 12 graduate credit hours. Students take two graduate-level courses per 14-week semester. One course will be entirely online in the evening and the other will be a hybrid class completed online along with three four-hour Saturday sessions of four hours each on site at Blumberg Institute in Doylestown, Bucks County.

Certificate Program students can transfer unduplicated certificate courses for credit toward a Master of Science in Biotechnology from Harrisburg University. You'll be about one-third of the way (12 credits out of 36 required) toward the MS degree when you complete any one of the three certificates.
